### Discussion activities key

- I Students can see a submarine moving through the ocean in the picture. The submarine is surrounded by fish and other deep-sea creatures. Some students might point out that the shape in the submarine's 'eye' looks like a person. Students should work out that the story will take place underwater, and that it will be filled with undersea adventures.
- 2 Possible answer:

When did the giant whale first appear? In 1866.

How big was it?

A hundred metres long.

How high did it send water into the air? Fifty metres.

What does it have on its head?

A spear.

How fast did it move in the water? Very guickly.

- 3 Students should recognise that the men are on a ship in the ocean. They are looking at something in the water. They seem to feel interested and excited.
